JSC participates in Code of Conduct established by The Responsible Business Alliance (RBA), formerly the Electro Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC). In compliance with the code of conduct related with conflict minerals, We hereby declares that JSC does not use conflict minerals derived from conflict region where serious violation of human rights and unfair profits are conducted during mining minerals in that we respect human rights and avoid direct or indirect involvement with inhuman acts.

We are thus willing to follow below actions as a part of our policy:□

- **Prohibit the use of conflict minerals derived from the conflict region.**
- **Educate and train internal and external interested parties.**
- **Audit suppliers to control of conflict minerals (Ta, Sn, W, Au).**
- **Perform risk assessments for all suppliers who provide minerals (Ta, Sn, W, Au).**
- **Stop any transaction in case of using any minerals (Ta, Sn, W, Au) from conflict region.**
- **Retain CMRT(Conflict Minerals Reporting Template) records.**
